# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PERALTA RETIREES ORGANIZATION

Ι

The name of this corporation is **PERALTA RETIREES ORGANIZATION**.

### Π

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit **PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION** and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purposes of this corporation are to:
  - \*provide assistance and information to, and representation for, the members in matters relating to retirement;
  - \*generate and distribute information and provide instruction concerning retirement issues;
  - \*initiate, sponsor, and encourage educational and other activities that will improve the general welfare of the members;
  - \*aid the greater Peralta Community College District community (College of Alameda, Laney College, Merritt College, Vista College, and Peralta Colleges Foundation) through volunteer service, to include, but not limit to, mentoring new faculty, tutoring students, and providing funds toward scholarships;
  - \*accept, maintain and expend funds by way of dues, grants, or from other sources to promote and advance these charitable and educational purposes.

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- C. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

#### V

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to **charitable** and **educational** purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provisions for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for **charitable** purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code.
